Dear West Valley Christian Preschool and School Families,

Thank you for choosing WVCS for your child's education. It is our privilege to serve your family. Each day we seek to serve you with excellence as we provide a balanced and dynamic Christian education for your precious child. We hope you are thrilled about how your child is developing socially, academically and spiritually and are ready to re-enroll your child for the 2019-2020 school year.

Existing families should re-enroll by February 22, 2019, since we anticipate several classes may reach capacity. To re-enroll, your 2018-2019 tuition account must be current. We cannot reserve a spot for your child(ren) for next year if your account is delinquent.

ELEMENTARY AND MIDDLE SCHOOL RE-ENROLLMENT: Please sign the Registration Contract by February 22, 2019. On February 25, we will open enrollment for new students. For your convenience, we will divide the \$530.00 enrollment fee into three payments (March, April and May). The first payment will be \$180 and \$175 for the remaining two months. The Supply and Activity Fee will be divided into two payments (June and July). If you do not plan to return, please notify us.

PRESCHOOL: WVC Preschool is offering several schedule options for our school families. Please be aware our preschool has reached its maximum capacity for the last three years and we have experienced wait lists for several of our age groups. Our preschool is also a year round program. Priority enrollment for our current families is February 19 – 28, 2019. On March 1, 2019, WVC Preschool will have open enrollment for all interested preschool families, including those on our waiting list.

SCRIP: Scrip is our school's major fundraiser. Families purchase gift cards (scrip) for regularly purchased household expenses, such as groceries, gasoline, etc. It costs nothing to participate, and our school receives a small percentage from the merchants when their gift cards are purchased from our school. We carry a large selection of cards for purchase, including American Express and Visa cards.

We require every family (Preschool - 8th grade) to purchase scrip (gift cards) during the school year (\$1,000 per semester). If a family does not participate in the program, a \$100 scrip non-usage fee will be billed after the first semester (in January) and \$100 after the second semester (in June, after the end of school). If a family purchases some scrip, but not the required amount, the fee will be prorated accordingly.

TUITION ASSISTANCE OPTIONS: 1) To renew your current 2018-2019 tuition assistance plan, we are offering two options. The first option allows you to avoid reapplying online by accepting a 20% reduction in your current assistance. The percentage of a family's current tuition assistance will automatically be reduced by 20%. This option will also guarantee an enrollment spot for your child. The second option is to file electronically online (<http://www.cts-tuition.com/app/weswesca/>) for tuition assistance by April 15, 2019, to continue your current assistance. You will have to wait until you receive your assistance determination before you can pay your Enrollment Fee and secure an enrollment spot for your child.

In closing, we would like you to take a moment and write an internet review so that new families can discover what you appreciate at WVCS.
